

Things which kept us going in 2019 ...

Drug Awareness Program

- Over a period of one year (2019), the program reached out to over 75,000 people raising awareness on the issue of drug consumption and its ill effects
- Rallies and street plays were organized on the de merits of drug usage in over 24 Govt. & private educational institutions in Nabha & Patiala involving 5500 students
- Large scale awareness camps and street

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- plays were conducted in 50 villages engaging 4100 individuals
- In depth discussions and close follow ups were done with people struggling with drug addiction
- Awareness building activities were organized in the Civil Hospital, Nabha, on the occasion of International Drug Abuse Day involving doctors and media coverage.

Phulkari Program

- In August 2019, Program's master artisan, Gurmeet Kaur, was selected as one of the ten artisans from across the country for the fellowship by The Hans Foundation and Fair Trade Forum.

The Nabha Foundation experienced 2019 as an exciting year pursuing the new vision of impact, scale and leverage through deeper engagement with the issues and concerns of rural and urban Nabha along with strong partnerships with the Government and other stakeholders. We reached out to the people of Nabha, consciously prioritizing those domains, which were affecting large number of people, especially, the most vulnerable population.

The three biggest overarching challenges today faced by Nabha are Environmental **Sanitation.** We have deep dived into these domains through our programs on Sustainable Farming, Drug Awareness in schools and communities, Town and Rural Sanitation. These programs have helped us further in understanding the magnitude, the complexities and the urgency of the problem. The sustainable agriculture program and engagement with the farmer community gives us hope that constant dialogue can enhance awareness on the importance of conserving water, using less chemicals and contributing towards cleaner air. There have been very positive examples and stories of initiatives taken by farmer collectives and individual farmers to

In September 2019, Phulkari team participated in a three exhibition day 'Vastrabharana' held in Mumbai organized by the Craft Council of India. Apart from this, two more exhibitions were organised by the team in Chandigarh. One was a two day exhibition 'Laado Pehla SHG mela' organized at Kisan Bhavan by the Department of Social Security and Development of Women and Children. Another one was an exclusive exhibition of Phulkari Mahila SHG products which received

heartwarming responses from the patrons and was covered by media as well.

 The team also participated in a fifteen day exhibition 'Dastkari Haat Samiti' at Delhi Haat , New Delhi. The exhibition was received by the patrons and that resulted into bulk of orders for the phulkari team.

Sustainable Agriculture Program

 Technical training programs were organised for the farmers on the practices of organic farming which influenced 126 farmers into practising sustainable experiment and bring about change in the farming practices. Similarly, engaging with communities, institutions and specially youth on the problem of substance abuse and communicating its gravity and devastating impact through folk media and peer dialogue further strengthened our belief that awareness is the first step towards change.

In the coming year, we surely are better positioned to sharpen our approach and strategies to deal with the challenges and together with the people of Nabha, we will continue to be an active part of Nabha's change story.

- agriculture impacting 141 acres of land in Nabha.
- This year, the program promoted Bio-fertilizer kits to 143 farmers in Nabha and 95 kits in Mansa.
- Promoted paddy crop residue management to all of its 300 farmers covering 451 acres of land in Nabha
- Joesph Rickman, a representative from Better Grain organisation in London, visited Nabha in December and interacted with the farmers on the significance of sustainable agriculture and its

impact on business potential globally.

Community Health Program

- Impacted over 800 female sex workers and male sex workers and their families in Nabha and Patiala.
- Over a span of one year, the team facilitated social security schemes for over 300 female sex workers and male sex workers and their families
- Facilitated the formation of SHG and linkage of bank credit amongst female sex workers.

- Orientation and awareness meetings were conducted with pregnant women, lactating mothers and ASHA workers on the significance of nutrition and institutional deliveries.
- Repetitive camps were organised in Nabha jail for HIV and Syphilis testing's. Registered the reactive inmates with ARTs for treatment. Also, covered a factory in Rajpura testing about 430 workers.
